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Display the following sentences in L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X output file, and space between two adjacent lines is 15pt.

“‘One’ or ‘Two’” he asked

“No, it is 1–2”

Repeat the sentence “ $\text{\LaTeX}$  is useful” in an enumerate list.  
Each statement has a different type style.

*Note: It may not be possible to get every combination with the default font.*

- 1 In bold & small caps style
- 2 In italic & huge style
- 3 In tiny & roman style



Display the sentence “L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X is not very easy” at different locations as following

L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X is not very easy (center)

L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X is not very easy (0.5-inch from left)

L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X is not very easy (1.5-inch from above)
