### Descriptions of Events for Individual Sponsorship

#### **Friday Dinner / Scavenger Hunt:**

The Friday Dinner / Scavenger Hunt is the kick-off event of the conference. It sets a tone for the conference and will prove to be a special event. All conference attendees will be treated to some of the South's finest BBQ as well as a scavenger hunt and ice breaker. The scavenger hunt will be a competition in which teams consisting of students from different universities will race to find notable sights and landmarks around Auburn University and downtown Auburn. Prizes will be awarded to teams based on speed and completeness.

#### **Saturday Breakfast:**

To start the day off right breakfast will be served for all conference attendees Saturday morning. The breakfast will be served buffet style near the morning event venues in Ross Hall.

#### **Saturday Lunch:**

All conference attendees will be brought together for lunch during the Saturday afternoon activities. The lunch will be served buffet style in a setting near the conference events on campus.

#### **Paper Competition:**

The Regional Student Paper Competition is the highlight of the conference. In this competition undergraduate students present their cutting-edge research and engineering. The subject of each paper is left entirely to the individual student. The presentations often focus on recent advances in some branch of chemical engineering, original research, or plant design. Participation in the Regional Student Paper Competition offers valuable, real-world experience for students. The First Prize winner represents the Southern Region at the Annual Student Conference Paper Competition in Philadelphia November 2008.

#### **Poster Competition:**

The Regional Student Poster Competition is rivaled only by the Paper competition. It is another highlight of the conference. Undergraduate students present some of their cutting edge research in the form of a poster. The focus of these posters is often on recent advances in some branch of chemical engineering, original research, or plant design. Participation in the Regional Student Paper Competition offers valuable, real world experience for students.

#### **Car Competition:**

Teams of students design and construct vehicles that are powered with a chemical energy source to carry a load a given distance. The vehicle is judged based on the combination of completion of a defined task and having the most creative design. This event is very popular among conference attendees who show their school spirit in cheering for their

car. First through fifth place winners qualify to represent the Southern Region at the national competitions at the AIChE meeting in Philadelphia in November 2008.

### Kickball Tournament:

The Kickball tournament will provide an opportunity for some friendly competition between the attending schools. Schools will compete in a round-robin style tournament for the title of Conference Kickball Champion. Prizes will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers. This event is a great opportunity for students to interact with others from different Universities in the fun-filled atmosphere of a kickball field. The competition will take place on the University Lawn near the Conference Center, Samford Hall and Ross Hall.

### Awards Banquet:

The Awards Banquet is a formal dinner featuring a guest speaker and award presentations for the Paper Competition, the Poster Competition, the Chem-E-Car Competition, and a Spirit Award. Sponsors will be introduced and acknowledged at this event, and sponsor representatives will be seated with award winning students and leaders in AIChE. The event will be held at the Auburn Conference Center Grand Ballroom.

### Sunday Officer's Breakfast:

The Sunday Officer's Breakfast is an opportunity for officers from each student chapter to meet and exchange ideas for the improvement of their chapters. Bids are presented and selections are made for hosts of future SRC conferences.
