Science Scholarships and Fellowships

The UNCF/Merck Science Initiative is an innovative program that creates opportunities in the biological and chemical sciences for African American students throughout the country. This program supports the training and development of world-class African American biological and chemical research scientists.

■ UNDERGRADUATE Science Research Scholarship Awards

- Scholarships up to \$25,000
- Two paid internships at Merck Research Laboratories with stipends totaling more than \$10,000
- Mentoring and networking opportunities
- Eligibility: College juniors, science majors, 3.3 GPA

■ GRADUATE

Science Research Dissertation Fellowships

- Fellowships up to \$52,000
- Mentoring and networking opportunities
- Eligibility: Ph.D. or equivalent degree candidates engaged in dissertation research in biological or chemical research fields

■ POSTDOCTORAL

Science Research Fellowships

- Fellowships up to \$85,000
- Mentoring and networking opportunities
- Eligibility: Ph.D. or equivalent degree recipients in biological or chemical research fields
